What is racial/ethnic composition of students with disabilities compared to the racial/ethnic composition of the entire district?

Comments

In analyzing Composition Indexes, look at the proportional representation of a racial/ethnic group in the district as compared to the proportional representation of the same group in special education. In 2005-2006 the composition index was one measure used by the California Department of Education (CDE) to identify districts with disproportionality. When the proportion of SWDs for any racial/ethnic group was more than 20% higher than it proportion in K-12 education the district met one of the two criteria for being identified as disproportionate. Likewise, when the proportion of SWDs for any racial/ethnic group. Though the composition criteria is not currently used to calculate disproportionality, they are included in this report.

Risk Ratios: Special Education Identification

Description

This table provide risk ratio calculations for each racial/ethnic group in the district. The relative risk is similar to the composition index in that it is the number of students in a particular racial/ethnic group classified as SWD divided by the number of total students in that same racial/ethnic group. A Relative Risk Ratio (Risk Ratio) is a comparison of the relative risks of a particular racial/ethnic group compared to the relative risks of the remaining racial/ethnic groups.

Question(s) for Analysis

How much more likely is it that a student from a given racial/ethnic group will be identified with a disability?

Comments

Relative Risk Ratio (Risk Ratio) is the ratio of two ratios. It allows one to specifically answer the question of how much more likely it is that a student from a particular racial or ethnic group, in a given setting, will receive a certain classification and/or placement than will students from all other racial and ethnic groups in that setting. Thus, if a particular racial or ethnic group's Risk Ratio is 2.0, it means that students from that racial or ethnic group are twice as likely to receive a certain classification than other students. If a particular racial or ethnic group's Risk Ratio is 1.0, it means that students from that racial or ethnic group are equally likely to receive a certain classification as other students, and if a particular racial or ethnic group's Risk Ratio is .50, it means that students from that racial or ethnic group are less than half as likely to receive a certain classification as other students.



DISTRICT ENROLLMENT: ETHNICITY/RACE








Gender Composition and Discipline Events by School










Top Referral Source and Student Frequency





Suspension Days and Consequences






Top 10 Incidents by Race/Ethnicity


